Directions: Using either CultureGrams or World Book online, you will explore the geography, people, and history of one of the Canadian provinces or territories. You will have three class periods in the library.

- Day 1 - Instructions and note taking
- Day 2 - Note taking and collaboration (note sharing and online discussions with other students)
- Day 3 - Create a slide show The slide show should contain:
 - 10 slides: 1 introduction slide and 3 slides per topic
 - Each slide must contain a picture and information
- Presentations for 1A, 2A, and 4A will be on November 18th
- Presentations for 1B, 2B, and 4B will be on November 17th

Note Taking: Take notes in your own words in Word. You will cut and paste your notes into our Wiki page. Use the summarization method shown in class. During class time, use only the sites provided. You may do additional research and use additional sites on your own time.

- B Blocks use World Book online

Collaboration (Note Sharing): Read the notes from the class opposite yours. In other words if you are in Block 1A, you will read the notes from Block 1B. You will be using different sites, so you should have different information. Combine this information with your information to get the complete picture. You must include notes from the other class.

Collaboration (Discussions): If you have any questions or need clarification, you can contact another student through the discussion tab. These discussions should always be related the topic.

Grade: You will be graded in three areas:

- 25% notes in your own words
- 25% collaboration (Using notes from another class and discussions for clarification)
- 50% slide show
